Hobson's Bay Yacht Club Inc. was formed in 1888 and since that time the Club has promoted amateur yacht racing and sailing. Members enjoy active racing and cruising within the Club and with other Yacht Clubs around Port Phillip Bay. Members also participate in many social activities organized by the Club's Social Committee.

The Yacht Racing Calendar offers events for both novices and more experienced members. Races range from short course to longer day and overnight races. During winter the Brass Monkey Series Races are held every second Saturday afternoon and Twilight Series Races are held each Wednesday evening during summer, followed by a BBQ or hot/cold snacks.

The Club cruising group regularly visits many places of interest around Port Phillip Bay and along the Victorian coastline. The group holds monthly meetings at which there are often guest speakers who provide entertaining talks on many aspects of yachting.

2012/2013 Membership fees (including GST), Slipping and Rental fees:

Senior Member: \$744.00 An additional nomination fee of **\$372** on application for new membership. Partners of senior members may become senior members by paying **\$372**, half of the annual Senior subscription (Family Member), an additional nomination fee of **\$186** on application for new membership

Pensioner Member: \$133.00 *Any member who is of Age Pension age or older and holds a Centrelink Pensioner Concession Card or a Department of Veteran Affairs Pensioner Concession Card and has been a senior member for at least five years may, on written application to the General Committee, be granted senior membership at a reduced rate of annual subscription as determined by the General Committee from time to time.*

Crew Member: \$319.00 An additional nomination fee of **\$80.00** on application for new membership.

Social Member: \$85.00 An additional nomination fee of **\$42.00** on application for new membership (membership allows access to club facilities as determined by the Committee, however social members cannot take any active role as a crew member in club organized sailing events).

Junior Member: \$106.00 (15 years of age to 20 years of age).

Cadet Member: \$32.00 (8 years of age to 14 years of age).

Marina Rental: \$2338.00 per year. (Including **\$128.00** annual Marina Maintenance Fee)

Hardstand Rental: \$2338.00 per year (Including **\$128.00** annual Hardstand Maintenance Fee)

Dinghy Rack: \$320.00 per year.

Locker: \$320.00 single **\$160.00** shared per year.

Slip & Scrub: \$212.00 for boats up to 11 metres in length and **\$234.00** for boats over 11 metres in length. Boat must be on the HBYC Club Register.

Yard Charges: Week 1 **\$22.00** ─ Week 2 **\$22.00** ─ Week 3 **\$43.00** ─ Week 4 **\$86.00** ─
Week 5 **\$128.00** (and thereafter)

Please enquire at the HBYC office for fees and charges for casual and non registered boats.

Yard Staff are available to carry out maintenance on members' boats and a scale of fees is available from the office. The club hall is available for members hire and the BBQ facilities are available all year round.

Visitors are very welcome to experience sailing from HBYC. If they wish to race or cruise and get involved in the Club, then we would like them to become a member. Any person who wishes to join the Club during the financial year pays on a pro rata basis.
